New York Upstate Regional Sunfish Championship

August 9-10, 2008

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 ISAF Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Boats should also be in compliance with the ISCA class rules. Boats may be subject to measurement during any time in the regatta.

2 Worlds

- 2.1 The top, not yet qualified, sailor in the regatta will be invited to the 2009 World Championship.

3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Competitors are encouraged to be a member of the Sunfish Class Association. Worlds hopefuls must show their class membership card at time of registration. You may also join the USSCA at time of registration.
- 3.2 All entrants must fill out Registration Form.
- 3.3 Participants postmarked by July 14, include \$45 registration
- 3.4 Participants registered after July 14, or on the day of the regatta, pay a \$50 registration fee.

4 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration. Any questions the participants have about the sailing instructions can be answered at the skippers meeting.

12:00 No race to begin after this time
1:30 Awards and Drinks at RCC

6 Courses

The courses will be held in Irondequoit bay, most likely south of the club house. The actual courses will be defined in the sailing instructions, but will most likely be a combination on: Windward-leeward, Triangle, and Olympic courses.

7 Scoring

- 7.1 This regatta will be scored by Low Point scoring as defined per RSS A4
- 7.2 When more then 6 races are completed a competitor's worst race will be thrown out
- 7.3 One (1) race will constitute a regatta.

8 Disclaimer and Liability

All competitors in the regatta are participating at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Rochester Canoe Club is not responsible for any damages or personal injury that should occur before, during, after, or because of this regatta. It is also the Canoe Club's policy that all racers will be required to have and wear a USGC approved life jacket at all times when racing.

9 Directions to RCC

The Rochester Canoe Club is located on the west side of Irondequoit Bay, North east of Rochester.

Take I-590 north to Ridge Rd exit 11.

Turn right (east) onto Ridge Rd and go 0.2 miles to Bayshore Blvd.

Turn right and go 0.3 miles to the entrance to RCC on the left.

Go down the steep driveway.
