



Notice of Race
2nd SUNFISH YOUTH WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP
The Organizing Authority is the International Sunfish Class Association,
Laser Performance and the Curaçao Sunfish Sailing Association
June 8-11, 2011

0. Reservations: We recommend making early hotel and flight reservations as soon as possible.

1. Rules: The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing and the rules of the International Sunfish Class Association, except as any of these altered by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Advertising: No advertising is allowed except as determined by the regatta organization.

3. Eligibility and Entry: Each competitor shall be a current year (2011) member of their respective country's Sunfish Class Association. Sailors must not reach their 19th birthday during the 2011 calendar year.

3.1 Number of Sailors: The regatta will be limited to a maximum of 50 sailors. Participation will be determined as follows: 5 from each non-U.S. NSCA, 8 from USSCA and 4 additional from CSSA as the host country. Non-U.S. entries will be on a first come, first served basis. NSCA's wishing to send additional competitors may apply for a waiting list by sending the registration and charter fees. Those registrations will remain on hold until April 1, 2011. Any open spots after April 1, 2011 will be filled from the waiting list, taking 1 competitor from each NSCA at a time, by the registration date, until all spots are filled. The remaining sailors from the waiting list will be fully refunded (no administration fee will be charged). Sailors will be notified of their eligibility by April 7, 2011. If all slots are not filled by April 1, 2011, the remaining slots shall be filled by sailors submitting the proper registration and fees on a first come, first served basis.

3.2 Non-U.S. NSCA Qualification: Each NSCA will determine its own country's qualification system.

3.3 U.S. Qualification: Sailors qualifying for the United States must submit a résumé that shows evidence of participation, over the two year period prior to the event, in the following categories: At least 25% their yacht club's Sunfish races, two Sunfish regattas held anywhere in the U.S. and at least one Sunfish world qualifier event. If the sailor's yacht club does not offer Sunfish racing, they may petition to have this requirement waived. However, for 2011, if a sailor cannot meet all of these requirements, they may petition the Sunfish Youth Coordinator to accept them for entry into the regatta.

All résumés must be submitted to the Youth Coordinator by March 15, 2011, at which time they will be reviewed. Sailors will be notified of their eligibility by March 30, 2011. Weighted consideration will be given to those sailors who have participated in national and regional events as well as their finishing positions in those events. If all US slots are not filled by March 30, 2011, the remaining slots shall be filled by sailors submitting the proper résumé, registration and fees on a first come, first served basis.

3.4 Advance Registration: Competitors may register by completing the entry form and sending it with the appropriate fees to ISCA, PO Box 300128, Waterford, MI 48330-0128 USA.

Registrations are not considered official until all fees have been received.

3.5 Payment Method: Payment may be made by credit card or by check in US dollars payable to "ISCA" drawn on a US bank.

3.5.1 Checks: If checks are used, the damage deposit must be sent with a separate check. The amount, whether credit or check, will not be cashed (paid) until the regatta and only in the event of damage.

3.5.2 Proof of Payment Date: When paying by check or wire transfer, a scanned copy of the check or the wire transfer receipt must be sent by email or fax to the ISCA office to confirm the payment date. For non-US participants, checks must be sent to ISCA by FedEx, DHL or UPS (regular mail is not recommended). The ISCA office will confirm the payment date when the original document is received and the date is compared with the one stamped by the mailing institution. If the document does not arrive within 10 days, the Class Office will ignore the copy of the check and use the real date of reception.

3.5.3 Other Payment Methods: In countries where it is not possible to send wire transfers, or use credit cards or checks, competitors will be allowed to reserve spots by sending a letter. However, the funds must be received, by some means, by one ISCA Officer by the registration deadline or the spots will be released. These types of registration will require the approval of the ISCA President and the ISCA Treasurer.

*Necessary for wire transfer – For registration to be complete, a \$25 US Dollar addition must be made to the transfer and shall not be deducted from the registration fees.

4. Fees: There will be a US\$100 Registration Fee per competitor. This includes the opening ceremony, 3 lunches and the awards dinner.

4.1 Charter Fees: US\$225 for Youth Worlds only
US\$525 for Youth Worlds and World Championship participation
Those Youth participating in the World Championship will be assigned the same boat assigned in the Youth Worlds.

4.2 Refunds of Fees: Entry and charter fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE** unless all 50 spots are filled by the date of the regatta. All entry fees to be refunded are subject to a 10% administrative fee.

4.3 Damage Deposit: US\$150

5.1 Number of races: The Race Committee will attempt to run 8 races. One race will constitute a regatta.

6. Measurement: All boats may be measured against the Class rules prior to and/or during the regatta.

7. Sailing Instructions: The wearing of life jackets during the regatta is required.

8. Venue: The regatta will be held at the Lions Dive & Beach Resort and the surrounding waters of Caribbean Sea.

9. Courses: The courses will be either Windward/Leeward, or Triangle or a combination thereof. In extraordinary circumstances the Race Committee may decide a different course.

10. Scoring: Scoring will be low point scoring system in accordance with Appendix A2 of the RRS except that one throw out will be given after 6 races have been completed.

11. Radio Communication: A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications unavailable to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12. Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top finisher of each race, the top 5 overall finishers as well as the top Midget and the top opposite sex. If 40 or more competitors are registered (by April 15, 2011), prizes will be awarded to the top 10 overall finishers as well as the top Midget and the top opposite sex.

13. Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14. Accommodation: The official regatta hotel is **Lions Dive & Beach Resort**, the sportiest hotel in Curaçao (www.lionsdive.com). It has its own private beach, the longest on the island. The Sunfish sailboats will be available and stored on this beach. Transportation between the hotel and the beach is therefore not necessary. **Hotel rooms and family apartments are available for a special rate, which cannot be found on the website.** The special rate will not be given to competitors if they contact the hotel directly, the request should go via the local organizers at sunfishworlds2011@gmail.com. If you are interested in receiving more information and hotel conditions, you can email the organization at sunfishworlds2011@gmail.com and we will forward your request to the hotel.

If you are already sure that you will be a participant, it is strongly recommended to make your hotel reservation now.

15. Transportation airport to the hotel: Participants may send the organizers an e-mail with flight data so that transportation from airport to the hotel can be arranged.

Please mention date, airline and flight number, and the number of people in your party, including sailor.

16. Weather conditions: June is usually a windy month, so winds of 12-15 knots and more can be expected. More information can be found on www.weather.an
