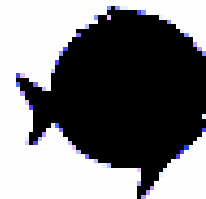

Notice of Race

1. Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is the Fairhope Yacht Club and the United States Sunfish Class Association (USSCA).

2. Rules: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the rules of the International Sunfish class (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

3. Advertising: This event shall be a Category A event in accordance with Appendix 1, Regulation 20 – ISAF Advertising Code.

4. Eligibility and Entry: This event is open to all current members of the International Sunfish Class. Membership cards will be checked at Registration. Anyone can join the Sunfish Class by completing a membership application at check-in. (Regional Event Requirement) Eligible yachts must complete a registration form with the registration committee. The top finisher qualifies for the 2008 Sunfish Worlds. (Regional Event Requirement)

10. Courses will be windward/leeward, triangle or any combination thereof.

11. Scoring will be the low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A of the racing rules, with ten races scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series. If six or fewer races are sailed, each yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

12. Trophies will be awarded to the five finishers. In addition trophies (for sailors NOT placing in the top five positions) will be awarded to the top Female, top Master over 40 and the top Juniors under 18
