Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is Wawasee Yacht Club and the United States Sunfish Class Association (USSCA)

1. **Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the rules of the International Sunfish class (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.
2. **Advertising:** This event shall be a Category A event in accordance with Appendix 1, Regulation 20 – ISAF Advertising Code.

Eligibility and Entry: This event is open to all current members of the International Sunfish Class. Membership cards & age will be checked at Registration.

8. **Courses:** Courses will be windward/leeward, triangle or a combination thereof.
9. **Scoring:** Scoring will be the Low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A of the racing rules, with six races scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series. If six or fewer races are sailed, each boats total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. If six races are completed, each competitor will be entitled to throw out its highest finish.
10. **Awards:** Awards to be given to the top **3 overall**, top Master, Junior and Woman.
