### **1. Rules**

This regatta is governed by:

1. The rules as defined in the 2017 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing
1. The Sunfish Class Rules

### **2. Qualifier**

The best, not yet qualified, sailor at this event is unconditionally invited to participate at the 2018 Sunfish World Championship

### **3. Eligibility and Entry**

3.1 Participants must be a member of the US Sunfish Class Association. Membership will be verified at registration. Participants may join USSCA at the time of registration.

3.2 All entrants must fill out an Entry Form at registration and submit a \$TBD registration fee.

3.3 Participants are reminded that per the class rules, 2 people may sail a boat together in the regatta so long as they sail all races this way.

### **5. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at registration. An opportunity exists to discuss any questions participants have about the SI at the skipper's meeting

### **6. Courses**

These will be defined in the Sailing Instructions. It is likely they will be:

Windward-Leeward or Olympic, with or without a start-finish in the middle, and possibly a gate in place of a leeward mark.

## **7. Scoring**

- 7.1 The Low Point System defined per RRS A4 will be used
- 7.2 When 6 or more races have been completed, there will be one throw-out
- 7.3. One (1) Race will constitute a regatta.

## **8. Radio Communication**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications unavailable to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile/cell telephones.

## **9. Prizes**

Trophies will be awarded to:

- 9.1 1<sup>st</sup>-3rd Place Overall
- 9.2 1<sup>st</sup> Junior (16 or under at time of registration)
- 9.3 1<sup>st</sup> Master (At least age 50 at time of registration)
- 9.4 1<sup>st</sup> Woman

## **10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
