**1. RULES:**

This regatta will be governed by current version of *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association and the rules of the ISCA (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions).

**2. ELIGIBILITY:**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to yachts of all classes.
- 2.2 Classes with four or more boats entered may compete as a class.
- 2.3 Sea Island One Design and all Junior classes need only three boats entered.
- 2.4 The Southeast Regional Championship is open to all current members of the USSCA <https://www.sunfishclass.org>. The top finisher, that has not already qualified, will qualify for the 2019 ISCA World Championship. If the top finisher elects not to attend the World Championship, the selection would then proceed to the next in-line finishers. All prior World Champions are automatically qualified.

**3. REGISTRATION and ENTRY FEES:**

- 3.1 Online registration is available on Yacht Scoring (YachtScoring.com).
- 3.2 All Junior Classes \$ 25 (includes 1 Regatta T-shirt)  
(Anyone 16 years of age and younger)
  - Single hand Classes \$ 35
  - Double \$ 40
  - Three Persons or more \$ 45

**4. SCHEDULE:**

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS and AREA:**

Sailing Instructions and course diagrams will be available at registration. All courses will be in Charleston Harbor.

**6. PENALTY SYSTEM:**

- 6.1 Rules V1 and V2 of Appendix V will be elaborated in the sailing instructions. including where to go for necessary forms to be completed and to whom it should be submitted.
- 6.2 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty (including one tack and one gybe).

**7. SCORING:**

- 7.1 An unlimited number of races are scheduled on all courses. One race completed will constitute a regatta.
- 7.2 The regatta will be scored with the low point system as described in RRS, Appendix A as amended to read that if more than 5 races are scored, each boat will exclude her worst score

**8. PRIZES:**

The number of trophies awarded will be determined by the number of boats entering each class, as described in the Sailing Instructions.

**9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:**

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. James Island Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
