NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1 The regatta is governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1 This regatta is open to any One Design sailboat fleet or class that belongs to a US Sailing member club or association. Three boats of the same class must be registered in order to qualify for a fleet start. The Race Committee may combine fleets for starts.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by signing up online at Regatta Network Registration. Registration will also be available on the first day of racing between 0830 and 1000 hours in the main club house of MBYC. See MBYC.org for link to registration page or call the MBYC main office.

3. Fees

3.1 Regatta pre-registration fee: Adults \$20/Juniors \$10. Day of Race: Adults \$25/Juniors \$15.

3.2 MBYC Luau Party is open to MBYC members and competitors registered for this regatta. Cost is \$27pp if paid day before Friday Aug 17, \$32pp day of. See MBYC.org for details.

4. Schedule

4.1 Saturday August 18

0830-1000 hours - On site registration.

1000 hours - Ocean competitor's meeting Club House deck.

1030 hours - Bay Competitor's meeting, Club House deck.

1200 hours- Warning for first race. Additional races to follow.

1700 hours- Band for Luau Party begins, dinner and entertainment to follow (see 3.2)

4.2 Sunday August 19

1200 hours- Warning for first race on Sunday. Additional races to follow.

Awards Ceremony: As soon as is practicable after racing and scoring.

*Awards for classes not affected by protest may be held while protests for hearings for other fleets are being held.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions are available at registration on Saturday August 18th.

5.2 If a conflict exists between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

6. Venue

6.1 There are two Venues: the sail bay portion of Mission Bay and the Pacific Ocean approximately one mile NW of the Mission Beach jetty. A representative of each fleet must inform the Organizing Authority of the venue in which they plan to race before 0930 hours on Saturday.

7. Courses

7.1 The courses to be sailed are described in the Sailing Instructions.

8. Scoring

8.1 The scoring system is the Low Point scoring system, appendix A of the RRS modified such that if fewer than 6 races are held a boat's score will be the total of all her race scores.

8.2 The Race Committee will attempt 6 races weather permitting. 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a Regatta.

9. Boat Storage and Car Parking

9.1 Boats may be stored at MBYC. Boats and trailers will be stored in the Dry Storage area. Information regarding acceptable locations will be available at the registration table. No boats or trailers may be left in the car parking lot.

9.2 Registered participants are issued parking permit for one car to park in the MBYC parking lot. Permits must be placed on the dash board of the car. Other cars must be parked outside.

10. Trophies

10.1 One Trophy for each three boats up to three trophies per class /fleet based on the number of pre-registered boats.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The Organizing Authority does not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.
