

## Todd Edwards wins Juby Wynne

Todd Edwards, in his last two regattas, led going into Sunday only to lose it by the end of each event, so a new strategy had to be tried. Though not intentional, of course, Todd ended up in the water at the start of race one when his hiking strap came loose. After wringing himself out, he would end up with a 4,1 on Saturday two points behind Bishop Stieffel's 1,2. Only two of three of the races scheduled on Saturday were sailed before a squall came through that, by the RC's equipment, clocked 63 kts sustained for a 4 minute period!!

Sunday's first race was a tight one with Clinton Edwards leading at the leeward mark by two lengths when Todd tried to sneak through a closed door inside of Bishop. Sailing to hold Todd back, Bishop covered him to the left side of the course and the two caught a major left shift leaving the rest of the fleet to fight for 3rd. Taking a three point lead into the last race, Bishop thought he was safe in simply staying clear but in sight of Todd. He did manage to keep clear, but quickly lost sight of Todd, Clinton and Peter Sladovich on the first leg. Rounding in sixth, Stieffel could only muster up enough speed to get within three boatlengths of Sladovich by the finish. Tied with identical finishes, Todd won the tiebreaker over Bishop by having the better finish in the last race.
